NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

- This is an AKC Sanctioned Match and wins at a Sanctioned Match carry no championship points.
- Dogs with Major points cannot be shown except in Open as FEO and Jr. Showmanship.
- Professional Handlers and their immediate family are limited to showing their own dogs.
- No tape or racks on ears permitted in the ring. Poodles must be in regulation clip.
- No dog with the CDX title may compete in any Regular Class except Utility. Such dogs may be entered and participate in the Open B Class, but may not compete for any awards in that class.
- No dog with the UD title may compete in any Regular Class. Dogs with the UD title may be entered and participate in the Open B or Utility Classes, but may not compete for any awards in these classes.
- Match Secretary will not exhibit at this match.
- Children must be kept under parental supervision at all times.
- The Judge will not wait for any dog holding up a class.
- **If, because of circumstances beyond the control of the match committee, it is impossible to open or complete this match, no refund of entry fee will be made.**
